Early earthworks Western Sydney Airport.

Dear neighbour,

Early earthworks for the Western Sydney Airport will continue until the end of the year. This work involves the movement of 1.8 million cubic metres of earth, stockpile management, and other key establishment activities.

Over the coming months, we'll deliver the following works:

- bulk earthwork activities
- vegetation clearing
- removal of de-energised overheard power lines and poles
- construction of a temporary roundabout
- removal of the site compound house
- re-alignment of Badgerys Creek Road
- construction of a new haul road

Works near Elizabeth Drive

We will be removing the compound house and carrying out vegetation clearing on our site in areas next to Elizabeth Drive between Badgerys Creek Road and Badgerys Creek. Additionally, power poles and two sets of de-energised overhead power lines that cut across Elizabeth Drive near the Taylors Road and Adams Road intersections will be removed. These works are planned for **Saturday**, **9 February 2019** between the hours of 7am and 5pm (weather permitting).

Works on or near Badgerys Creek Road

We will be carrying out vegetation clearing on our site next to Badgerys Creek Road between Elizabeth Drive and Longleys Road. Construction will begin for a temporary roundabout and access point on Badgerys Creek Road.

Traffic changes on local roads

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.

Measures will be in place to minimise impacts to you during the work. These include temporary speed zones, traffic controllers and temporary barriers around work areas.

If you travel in the area, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

Managing and reducing dust impacts on the Early Earthworks site

As part of our early earthworks program for the Western Sydney Airport, we have a range of methods in place to manage and reduce dust impacts in line with Airport Conditions.

Measures in place on the early earthworks job site to reduce dust impacts include:

- minimising exposed areas,
- re-vegetating exposed areas and or soil stockpiles as soon as practicable,
- spraying exposed areas with adhesive polymers
- using hessian, mulches or tackifiers to cover exposed areas
- using water-assisted dust sweepers on the access and local roads;
- avoiding dry sweeping of large areas and sealing high use haul roads;
- regularly inspecting and making necessary repairs to the surface as soon as reasonably practicable;
- regularly cleaning and damping down hard surfaced haul routes with fixed or mobile sprinkler systems or mobile water bowsers;

CPB Lend Lease JV carry out regular site inspections including dust monitoring throughout the site to ensure compliance with the Air Quality Management Plan.
