Early earthworks for Western Sydney International

Dear Neighbour,

Finishing works for Western Sydney International Early earthworks project will continue throughout March and April.

Construction hours will be from 6am to 7pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 6pm on Saturday.

Earthworks and finishing activities

Cut and fill of the final 150,000 cubic metres of earth from the old Badgerys Creek Road alignment is continuing. Scrapers will be used during this work, as well as other heavy machinery.

Other works to be carried out include building drainage basins, hydromulching and placing top soil as well as general civil construction activities. Early earthworks activities are expected to be completed in the coming months.

Elizabeth Drive and Badgerys Creek Road

Motorists can now use the new section of Badgerys Creek Road and the new roundabout on Elizabeth Drive. The former roadway is used for authorised construction vehicles only.


Please keep to the speed limits, follow the direction of traffic controllers and electronic message signs and allow additional travel time.
