

Dear Neighbour,

Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airports, Airside Civil and Pavements contractor (ACP), CPB ACCIONA Joint Venture, will begin laying asphalt to connect airside roads to the terminal. There will also be low-noise line marking works taking place on these airside roads once asphalt placement is completed.

## When will work commence?

Works will commence in late November 2024 and continue until March 2025. Works will be completed outside of our standard construction hours, show below.

Monday to Friday 5am – 8pm

Saturday 5am - 8pm

Sunday 6am - 6pm

## How is asphalt made?

Asphalt is a perishable material as it needs to be placed while hot. Producing asphalt involves combining aggregates such as sand and/or crushed rock in a rotating drum and removing the moisture by drying the materials at temperatures between 150 and 180 degrees Celsius. This material is then mixed with fillers such as lime and coated in bitumen in a mill. The asphalt will then be placed in trucks and taken to the airfield roads for paving.

Our contractor will be required to carry out noise monitoring in the shifts outside of standard construction hours to monitor for compliance with our noise management conditions.
